Entries

EISA Carnival entries should be made with Bullitt Timing via your Team Entry Form by noon on Wednesday, January 15. Make your entries on the "HAR" tab, including open entries. The entry fee for open entries is \$30 per skier per race, payable to Harvard University. Payment (check or cash) for open entries may be made at the race.

Race Courses

The Dublin School Nordic Center 5km course map and homologation certificate are attached. We will be racing the red loop, followed by the blue loop for each 5km lap. Venue maps, course maps, parking instructions and medical plan will also be posted to the virtual coaches meeting.

Streaming

Harvard Athletics will be live-streaming Saturday's mass start race. The race can be viewed on <u>ESPN+</u>, which is an online-only channel. Subscriptions for ESPN+ are \$4.99 per month, and our race can be viewed by subscribing for January only.

Venue Notes

- Only team vehicles and one support car (for tailgating) will be allowed to park at the venue to preserve access in the case of an emergency. All other vehicles will park at the Dublin School and take a 5 minute shuttle to the venue. Shuttles will run every 10 minutes on Friday and every 5 minutes on Saturday.






